UNISON offers grants to help members who wish to study Trade Union & Labour Movement and Women's Studies courses.

The grants available to members studying at their own expense are:

- Certificate or Diploma Grants of up to £300 for members on Trade Union and Labour Movement or Women's Studies courses
- ❖ BA Grants of up to £500 for members on Trade Union and Labour Movement or Women's Studies courses
- Masters Degree Grants of up to one-third of fees for a union representative studying Trade Union and Labour Studies or Women's Studies.

UNISON Educational Grants 2018

Trade Union & Labour Studies and Women's Studies

Certificate or Diploma Grants for members on Trade Union and Labour Movement or Women's Studies courses: UNISON offers a limited number of grants towards course costs for members studying part-time. Course costs include fees, residential sessions, travel, and course books. The number and size of grants offered depends on course costs and the number of applicants. It is usually around £300. Preference is given to members who do not already have a qualification at this level or above. We are keen also to hear from members who are actively involved in their branch.

BA Grants for members on Trade Union and Labour Movement or Women's Studies courses: A limited number of grants of up to £500 towards course costs for members studying part-time. Course costs include fees, residential sessions, travel, and course books. Members may want to apply to the government backed Student Loan Company for a fee loan. The number and size of grants offered depends on course costs and the number of applicants.

Masters Degree Grants for union representatives studying the Trade Union and Labour Movement or Women's Studies A limited number of grants of up to one-third of annual fees are available to union reps studying part-time at their own expense*. The size and number of grants will depend on fees charged and the number of applications received. These grants are aimed at UNISON activists wishing to further their trade union experience and consideration will be given to the level of activity of applicants within their branch.

For all grants listed above a copy of your course registration and proof that you are personally paying the full cost of course fees will be required before a grant can be paid. This can be a receipt for fees or a copy of your student finance agreement. * In certain circumstances we may look at offering a grant even if you are receiving money from elsewhere.

General Grant Criteria

- The deadline for receipt of applications is **31**st **July 2018**. Decisions on grants are deferred until then so that all applications can be considered at the same time against the criteria. Applications after that date will be considered if funding is still available.
- You must be a member of UNISON for at least 4 weeks prior to applying for a grant, have no arrears
 of subscriptions, and continue to pay membership subscriptions during the time you are supported
 by a grant.
- Each member can only receive one UNISON educational grant in each calendar year, up to a maximum of four grants.
- You usually need to be paying the full course fee yourself to be eligible for this grant, however some
 exceptions may apply. (If you have a query on this please contact
 LearningAndOrganising@unison.co.uk).
- Grants are made at the discretion of the NEC Development & Organising Committee.
- Where possible grants are paid directly to the college or institution where you are studying and, if not, to your bank account by BACS payment please complete the BACS payment form attached.
- There are no trade union and labour studies financial grants available for PhD study or research.

How do I apply?

- 1) Complete and sign the application form and the BACS form.
- 2) Copy your course registration and proof that you are paying the full cost of course fees yourself (receipt / student finance agreement).
- 3) Give the application form to your branch* and ask them to complete section 2 (payments may be delayed if this section is blank when received by the Bursaries administrator as the forms have to be sent back to the branch).
- 4) Ask the branch to send the application form back to the address on the form (it can also be scanned & emailed).
- 5) Return your completed BACS form and the proof of registration and payment direct to the Bursaries administrator.

Forms must reach us by 31st July 2018.

Please note that we cannot process the application until we have received the signed application form (both sections 1 & 2), your proof of payment and your BACS form.
